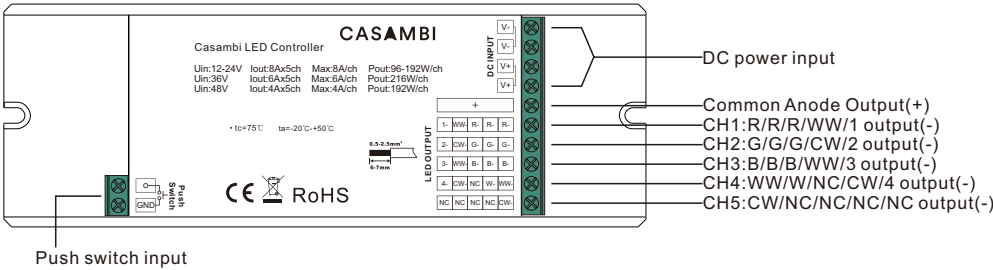

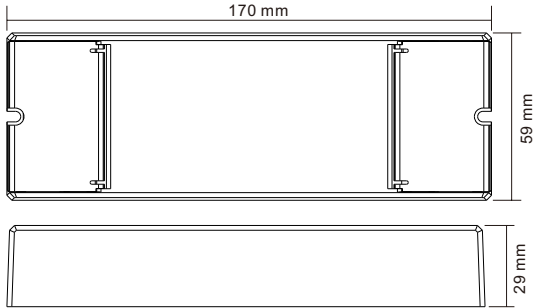

- Can be controlled by both Casambi App and Casambi wall switches
- Easy commissioning with Casambi App
- Casambi bluetooth, 2.4GHz radio frequency
- Radio range: 164 feet (50m) in open field. Actual range is dependent on field installation
- Can be controlled by existing push switches
- Push switch can be configured through Casambi App to control elements, luminaires, groups, scenes
- Waterproof grade: IP20

Operation

7 profiles can be selected through Casambi App:

- RGBTW (RGB and tunable white separate control, no mix)
- RGB+TW (RGB and tunable white mix enabled)
- RGBW (RGB and white separate control, no mix)
- RGB+W (RGB and white mix enabled)
- RGB
- 2xTW (2 tunable white lights separate control)
- 4ch DIM (4 channel single color lights separate control)

Select Profile:

The factory default profile of this device is RGBTW, you can switch to other control modes through the operation of “Change profile”. In the Luminaires tab, double-click the device, choose “Change profile” from the pop-up menu, and select the profile, as shown in the following figures.

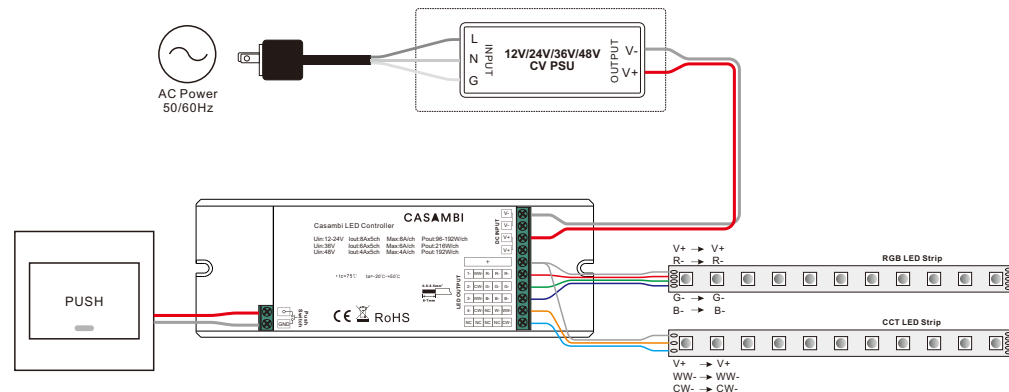
Firmware OTA Update:

To upgrade the firmware, first tap “check for updates” on the Nearby devices page, then navigate to the Luminaires tab, double-click the device, and choose “Reload fixture profile” from the pop-up menu to upgrade to the latest firmware, as shown in the following figures.

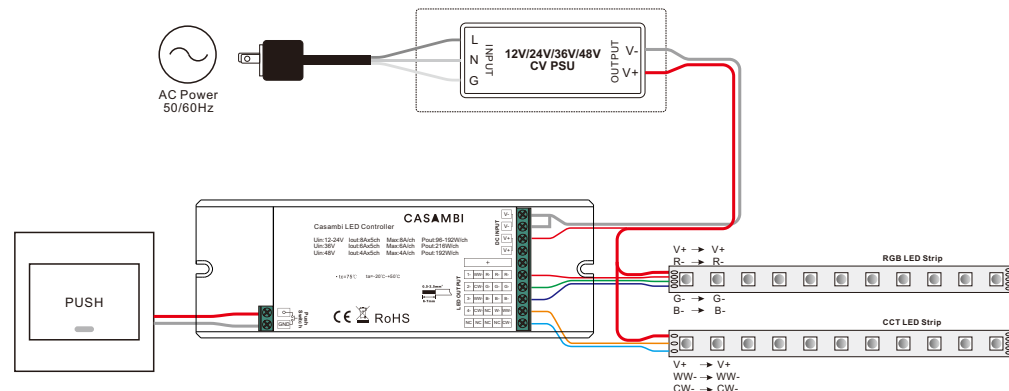
Wiring Diagram

1) When total load of each receiver is not over 20A

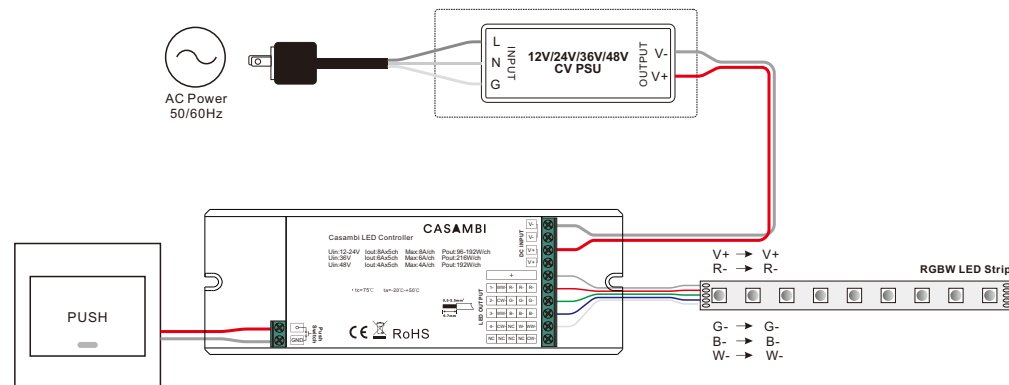


2) When total load of each receiver is over 20A

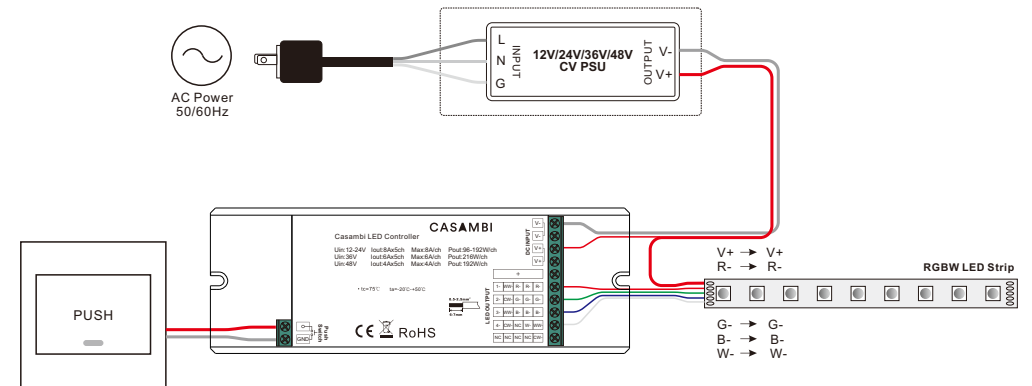


RGBW & RGB+W Mode

1) When total load of each receiver is not over 20A

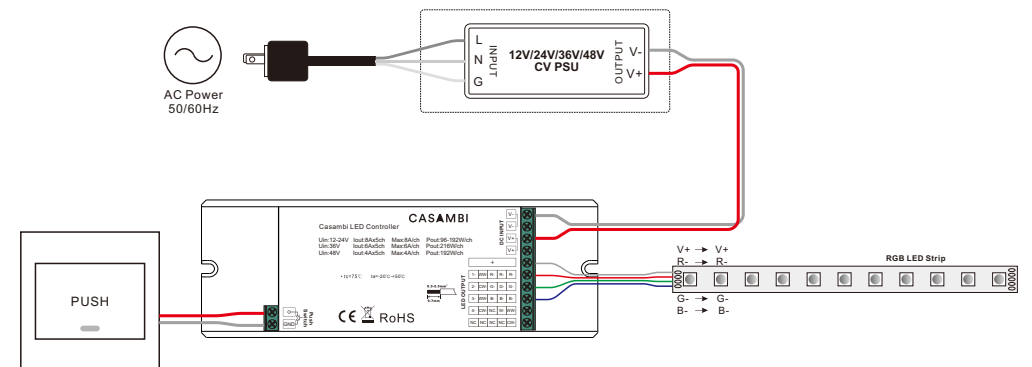


2) When total load of each receiver is over 20A

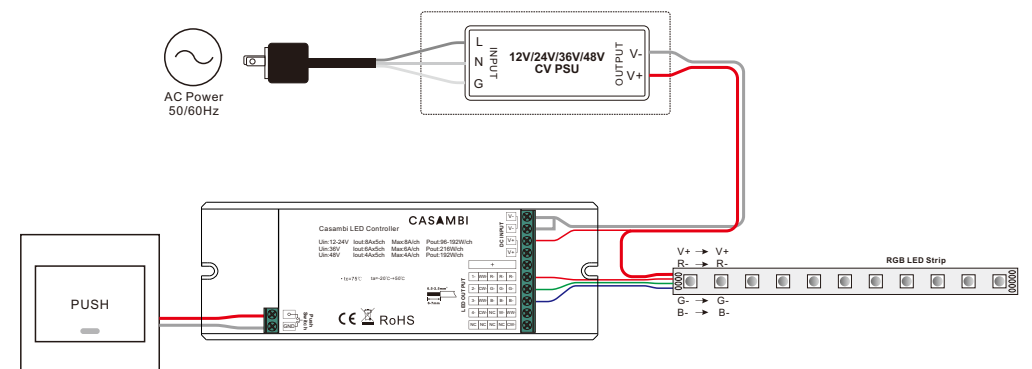


RGB Mode

1) When total load of each receiver is not over 20A

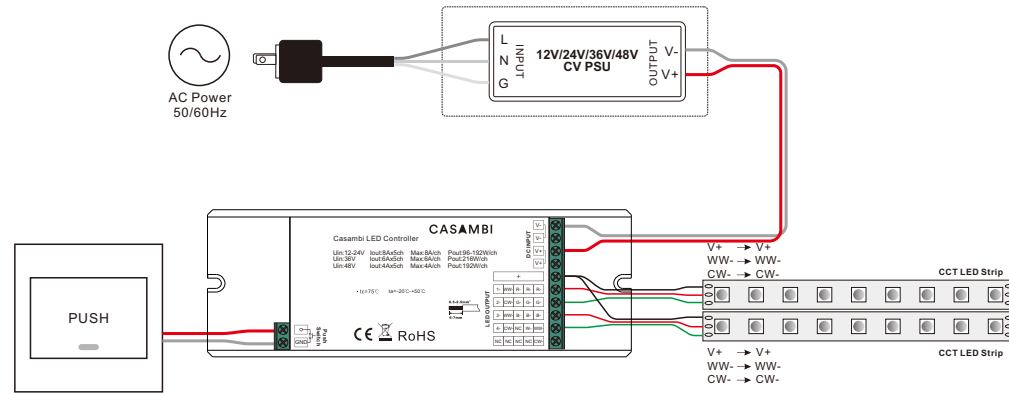


2) When total load of each receiver is over 20A

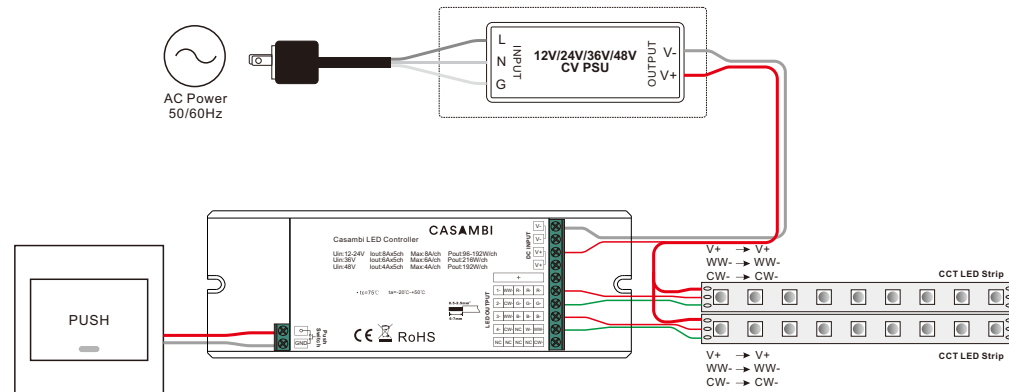


2xTW Mode

1) When total load of each receiver is not over 20A

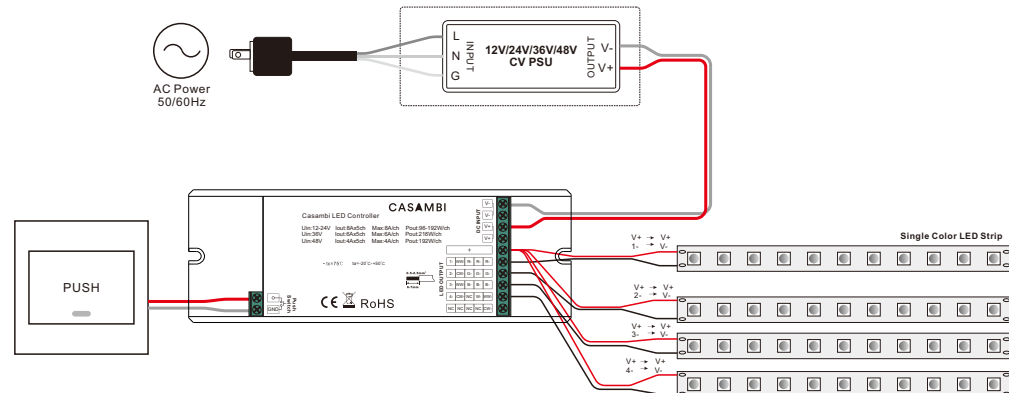
